

**CODE OF CONDUCT – 2010-2011

St. Paul's Christian Education Committee has formulated a Code of Conduct for groups and organizations using the church. Sunday School classes may add "policy" that pertains to their individual classroom. Parent(s) and children are asked to sign the attached paper and return it to their teacher next week. Thank you for helping to make our church a safe place for all children.

☺ Parents, please be sure adult supervision is in place before dropping children off for Sunday School or other events. Safety of all of God's children is a priority here at St. Paul's.

☺ Only Kind Words are spoken here! There should be no put-downs. Treat everyone as a child of God. Like Jesus said, "Treat others as you want to be treated."

☺ God gave us hands to help ourselves and to serve others. Use your hands to do only good things! No hitting, poking, or pestering others.

☺ Please respect God's written word – the Holy Bible should be treated with respect. Do not tear or "dog-ear" pages. Do not write in Bibles.

☺ Toys and personal property should be left at home. There are preschool toys for small children to play with in the churchtime nursery. Please do not bring electronic games or remote-controlled vehicles to play with at church.

☺ Parents of preschoolers who use the churchtime nursery are responsible for leaving the nursery neat and clean.

☺ Food and Drink stays in the Fellowship Hall, except, of course, the Body and Blood of Christ served at the altar!

☺ Respect one another. God gave us voices to uplift one another. Be respectful of your teachers and of one another. Only one person should speak at a time.

☺ This is God's house. Treat things here as you would want your things treated. Stay in the area of the church where your activity is taking place.

☺ Please do not wear "heelies" shoes to church or Sunday School.

☺ Please stay away from any equipment that may be stored outside.
