In keeping with tradition, there will be an opportunity for a love offering throughout the week. Children are invited to bring kid-friendly foods for the Friendly Hands food bank. With it being summertime, children are home from school and may not have the food they enjoy most. Healthy choices are best but things like cereal, mac & cheese, ready to serve canned pastas & meat, snacks, peanut butter and jelly, crackers, popcorn & pretzels, and fruit juices can all be helpful to parents who are trying to make ends meet.

Our offering on Thursday will benefit the Community Soup Kitchen in Torrington. It serves the entire northwest corner of the state and any monetary gifts are gratefully accepted to help offset the costs of providing a healthy and nutritious meal each day for anyone needing it. An offering envelope will be mailed as the time gets closer.

The cost for each child is \$25.00 for this week of fun and Christian growth (\$75.00 maximum for siblings); this will permit us to supply each child with all materials, craft supplies, and more. Please note, a limited number of VBS scholarships are available for those unable to pay the registration fee. Please call the church office for details.
